**Characters: Bouc - Poirot - MacQueen - Doctor Constantine** 

**Situation : MacQueen's second interrogation** (syllables in bold letters are stressed syllables)

#### **POIROT**

Mr MacQueen, do come in ! I have discovered Mr Ratchett's real identity.

## **MacQUEEN**

You mean...

### **POIROT**

Yes, Mr Ratchett was Cassetti. He organized the kidnapping of Daisy Armstrong. Of course, you didn't know that?

# **MacQUEEN**

Oh no! If I had known... I would have used my hands to strangle him, not to type his letters.

Ooops, you'll be sus**pec**ting me now...

#### **POIROT**

No. I f you regretted him, yes I would.

# **MacQUEEN**

Daddy – my father – was the **pro**secutor at the trial. Mrs Armstrong and her husband met him several times.

She was so friendly and benevolent. She was interested in what I wanted to do : become an actor. She was like a mother to me.

### **POIROT**

### **POIROT**
