In the night of Wednesday 18th to Thursday 19th, MSC Napoli was run aground in the Channel, near the British coast because of the storm “Kirill”.

MSC Napoli was found on January 19th near the British coast 100 km off Ouessant because of the storm named “Kyrill” which caused a crack in the hull but the twenty-six members of the crew were saved.
