MSC Napoli

MSC Napoli left Antwerp (Belgium) on January 17th for sines (Portugal) but it was run aground because the weather conditions were bad. There was a storm all over Europe.



The coastguard ships said they saw a waste of 200 tons of oil spilled on 8 km. Teams will begin to pump the liquid on Tuesday, January 23rd for one week. One third of the fuel has been pumped from MSC Napoli into another tanker but there are still 3,500 tons in the tank. 26 members of crew have been evacuated by helicopter.

The beach is becoming a giant garbage, 200 containers ran aground the beach and the ship owner has found 3 containers full of toxic products. People have discovered a lot of things (motorbikes, shoes...) in front of policemen : it's not forbidden by the law. Fuel arrived on the French coasts between Perros-Guirrec and Lézardrieux. Two special crane barges are sailing from the Netherlands.



Up to 1,000 seabirds are affected by the oil slick. According to the Royal Society 600 of them are likely to die.

This is a real tragedy for nature. How can we stop the petrol ? A boat shouldn't sail when it has already had problems before. This accident hit the English and Brittany coasts. It was very important and the consequences will really be disastrous for the sea and the people for a long time.
