Enormous Ship Run Aground off Branscombe Coast

The Napoli ship was towed on January 23rd in the southwest of England because of an enormous storm. It came from Anvers and was going to Portugal.

On Sunday, January 21st the British container MSC Napoli was run aground in the Southwest of England, near Sidmouth. An anti pollution system was installed around the Napoli.

In the containers there were motorbikes, spare parts, 1700 tons of toxic products: perfume, chemicals, agricultural products. The containers were 12 metres long.

More than 1,000 birds were touched. The coast of Perros-Guirec and Lezardrieux was affected too
