Oil Tanker near English coast

On 18th January, an oil tanker called Napoli began to sink with its 3,500 tons of hydrocarbon. MSC Napoli iwa sinking because it had a serious structural failure and because it was taken in a storm.

MSC Napoli transported 2,394 containers too and it had lost 103 containers among witch 4 contained dangerous substances. 76 containers have been recovered and 4 others were dangerous ones.

The Napoli measures 275 m long and 37.18 m wide.

The risk of pollution was important because the blobs of oil around 50 cm diameter were found on the beach in Côtes-d'Armor in France and in the UK a lot of items (bikes, wines) were found near the beach. The pumping operation began on Tuesday 23rd and the coastguard s rescued approximately 200 tons a day in the sea. On Monday 29th the recovery of containers began.

This accident is really dangerous for the environment because if this type of accident still happens the Channel could be polluted.
