Queen Victoria (24 May 1819 – 22 January 1901)

- born in Kensington Palace, London
- father (die) of pneumonia January 1820
- uncle, the Prince of Wales, (become) King George IV
- 11 years old : King George IV (die) → brother : King William IV
- 1837 : King William IV (die) (become) Queen Victoria
- 1840 : (marry) Prince Albert of Saxe-Coburg and Gotha (cousin)
- (have) 9 children
- 1861 : Prince Albert (die) Queen Victoria (be) extremely sad
- 1901 eldest son, the Prince of Wales (reign) as King Edward VII
- (reign) over 63 years, the longest reign in British history! The Victorian Era (be) synonymous with the expansion of the British Empire and the Industrial revolution.
